Umag, Croatia 1-6 May 2016

The International Team Competition for Men and Women in the 35-45 years age groups.

Cups will be allocated to venues at the entry deadline.

* Please note that ATP Stadium Umag and TC Umag are classed as one venue and some matches may be moved from one club to another if court space dictates it.

Dates: Sunday 1 May - Friday 6 May 2016

Please note that in the event of bad weather or other unforeseen circumstances, the ITF reserves the right to play on <u>Saturday 7 May</u>. <u>Participating teams should take this into consideration when making travel arrangements in order to comply with Section II, Rule 16 of the ITF Seniors Regulations.</u>

The competition will take place in accordance with the ITF Rules of Tennis and the ITF Seniors Regulations, which include the Regulations for the ITF Seniors World Team Championships and the ITF Seniors Code of Conduct.

The Competition will be played on a round robin basis, followed by knock out in the later stages where appropriate, to give a complete ranking of all teams. Each tie will consist of two singles and one doubles rubber. According to Section II, Rule 21 of the ITF Seniors Regulations, each team must consist of a minimum of two (2) players and a maximum of four (4) players, one of whom is designated captain. Alternatively, a non-playing captain can be nominated in addition. Players must have reached the appropriate age by 31 December 2016 and must have a valid Seniors IPIN.

The Change of Ends tie-break will be used during the 2016 ITF Young Seniors World Team Championships for every tie-break. As per Appendix IV of the ITF Rules of Tennis, "Change of Ends": "During a tie-break game, players shall change ends after the first point and thereafter after every four points".

Matches will be played over the best of three tiebreak sets. The seven point tiebreak will operate at six games all in all in each set.

A copy of the passport will have to be sent with the nomination form for those players who have not played in the Competition in the last four years.

A copy of the ITF Seniors Regulations will be available for all team captains at the Captains' Meeting, along with a finalised list of team entries and nominations. The event formats can be found on the ITF Seniors website.

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Entry deadline for National Team entries<u>MONDAY 8 FEBRUARY</u>

Deadline for nomination of players MONDAY 21 MARCH

According to Section II, rule 9 of the ITF Seniors Regulations, all nominated players must

be in possession of a valid Seniors IPIN

Please note that the entry fee must be paid by the National Association only, not by individual players. The National Association will receive an invoice shortly after the entry deadline. Entry fees of teams which subsequently withdraw from the event will not be refunded.

WITHDRAWALS

According to section II, regulation 16 of the ITF Seniors Regulations, any team that withdraws its entry later than 28 days prior to the scheduled first day of play in the Competition may have its entry refused for the following year's Competition and shall be liable for a fine of up to four times the amount of the entry fee. Any team that

- i) Is a no show
- ii) fails to play all its ties, including placement ties; or
- iii) is disqualified for an offence committed in the Competition

may have its entry refused for the following year's Competition and shall be fined. The fine shall be no greater than four times the amount of the entry fee.

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TRANSPORT

Air: Ronchi Legionari International Airport in Trieste, Italy is situated approximately 112km (69 miles) from the hotel complex in Umag.

<u>Train:</u> Koper train station in Koper, Slovenia is situated approximately 35 km (21.7 miles) from Umag.

All team members will be taken from Ronchi Legionari International Airport in Trieste or Koper Train Station to the official hotels only from Wednesday 27 April – Saturday 30 April, provided that Mr Igor Vasilic (World Championships Organizing Committee) receives the Player Arrival Form no later than Monday 4 April. There will be no transport from Zagreb.

Please note that there will be a charge for accompanying persons as follows:

- cost of a two-way ticket from Ronchi Legionari Airport in Trieste, Italy to one of the Umag hotels (and back to the airport) is € 50 per person.
- cost of a two-way ticket from Koper Station, Slovenia to one of the Umag hotels (and back to the station) is € 40 per person.

Accompanying persons will be required to pay on arrival. Please note that payment will be accepted in Euros or Croatian Kuna - if paying in Croatian Kuna the exchange rate of 26 April will be used to calculate the charge.

Please note that players arriving at Ronchi Legionari International Airport in Trieste, Italy will require a visa for the following countries: Italy, Slovenia and Croatia, as the transport route transits via Slovenia. Players arriving at Koper Train Station in Slovenia will require a visa for the following countries: Slovenia and Croatia. Please also read the visa requirements section on page 6 of this fact sheet.

Players should look out for the ITF Young Seniors World Team Championships welcome desk which will be displaying signage with the ITF logo.

In order to benefit from this service, please complete and return the <u>Arrival Form</u> to Mr Igor Vasilic (details given on form) by <u>Monday 4 April.</u> If required, teams will be returned to Ronchi Legionari International Airport in Trieste or Koper Train Station on Saturday 7 and Sunday 8 May, following the conclusion of the event. 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REGISTRATION

The registration desk at the ATP stadium in Umag (for all Cups) will be open on Wednesday 27 April 10am-6pm, Thursday 28 April from 10am-6pm, Friday 29 April from 9am-6pm, Saturday 30 April from 9am-6pm. Captains must register their teams during this period, before the start of their respective Captains' Meeting. Players must personally collect their accreditations from the welcome desk at the ATP Stadium. All accreditations will include a photograph, which will be taken onsite by the host organisers.

TROPHIES

Trophies will be presented to the winning teams, together with medals presented by the ITF. The losing finalists and third placed teams will also receive medals presented by the ITF.

The Captain of each winning team will have to take the trophy to his/her home country on behalf of his/her national association. The national association must then ensure that it is engraved and delivered in good time to the 2017 ITF Young Seniors World Team Championships.

DRESS ON COURT

Players and captains are strongly recommended to dress at all times on court in compliance with Team Identification principles. To comply a player and captain shall display the country's name on the back of his/her shirt or he/she shall dress in national colours. Team Identification shall be in accordance with the Official ITF Seniors Style Guide. Members of a doubles team shall be dressed in substantially the same colours.

MEDICAL & TRAVEL INSURANCE

According to Section II, Rule 27 of the ITF Seniors Regulations, players are responsible for checking with their local health authority regarding medical recommendations for travel to the country hosting the ITF Young Seniors World Team Championships.

Each national association is responsible for ensuring that all members of their team(s), and any accompanying officials in their delegation, are fully and adequately covered by insurance for the purposes of attending and participating in the ITF Young Seniors World Team Championships.

The ITF Ltd, the host association and the host site cannot accept any liability for any participant or visitor in this respect.

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VISA RECOMMENDATIONS

If you are flying into Trieste airport, you will require a visa for Italy, Slovenia and Croatia, as the transport route transits via those countries.

If you are arriving by train to Koper train station, you will require a visa for Slovenia and Croatia.
